What Information is Sunrise gathering about its visitors, and how is it being used?

Every computer connected to the Internet is provided with a domain name (e.g. stjohwna.com) and an IP Address (e.g. 10.0.0.1). When a visitor requests a page from within the stjohwna.com Web site, our Web Servers automatically identify and log the HTTP request that is made to our Web Server. The information so collected, none of which reveals anything personal about you, includes:

- The IP address of the site that may have referred you
- Your IP address
- The web page that you may have linked to us from
- The version and make of browser (e.g. Internet Explorer 6)
- The operating system that you may be running (e.g. Windows)
- Search words that are passed from a search engine (e.g. Google or MSN)

This practice of collecting this data is generally standard on all web servers on the Internet today, and allows us to track visitor traffic to verify that our website is compatible with the various browsers and operating systems of our visitors, and to track the effectiveness of our promotion of our website and its relevance to our customers and potential customers.
